First Aid

If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If on Skin: If on skin or clothing. Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 to 20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If Swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

General Information

Medalist soil surfactant, when used in a water management program, will distribute water more uniformly through the root zone thereby minimizing localized dry spot, enhancing turf quality and reducing watering frequency. Medalist can be used with irrigation injection systems.

Medalist contains ingredients derived from renewable resources. This nonionic surfactant provides safe, effective treatment of highly maintained turf when used in accordance with label directions.

Directions For Use - Application Guidelines

Medalist is formulated for use on golf courses, athletic fields, residential and commercial turf and landscape areas.

Tank Mix Spray Applications: Apply 16 to 24 fluid ounces, diluted in 40 to 50 gallons of water, per acre. Repeat monthly, or as needed.

Irrigation Injections: Apply 24 fluid ounces of Medalist in water volume sufficient to treat one acre of treated area. Use monthly throughout the growing season.

Soil Mixes: Apply 4 fluid ounces diluted in 3 gallons of water, then apply as a drench to each cubic yard of soil mixture, or 1,000 square feet of planting area.

Mixing

Tank mix combinations containing Medalist have not been tested under all growing conditions. Applicator should follow instructions of pesticide label to determine such use. Always exercise caution when using wetting agents with other commonly used turf chemicals and fertilizers. Test a limited turf area prior to large scale applications.

Storage and Disposal

Keep container tightly closed.

Storage: Store in original container only.

Disposal: Triple rinse container, empty rinse water into spray or stock tank. Dispose of empty container in accordance with federal, state and local laws.
