- Sprinkle approximately 1 level teaspoonful (5 ml) of Nature's Aid Granular Garden Inoculant lightly in the furrow, in each 2 foot (0.6 meter) of row.
- · Place the seed in the row and cover with fine soil.
- Treats up to 40 feet (12 meters) of row.

#### **Directions For Use (Shaker Can)**

Note: Use only on the specified legume seed.

- · Prepare seed bed for planting.
- Make furrow and plant legume seed into furrow without covering seed with soil.
- · Using blunt device, open the container top.
- · Rotate the lid to either shaker holes or wide opening to disperse inoculant.
- Apply granular inoculant in the furrow next to the seed. Apply ample amounts to ensure proper nodulation of emerging roots. Over-application is not detrimental and has shown to be beneficial.
- · Cover the seed and inoculant with soil.
- To ensure optimum performance of Nature's Aid Garden Soil Inoculant, water plants as directed throughout growing season.
- · Treats up to 150 feet (46 meters) of row.
