Directions For Use

Read label before use. Anti-Foam should be added to the spray mixture before the pesticide or any additional surfactant is added. Agitation is recommended to aid in dispersion of the various components.

General Use Rate: Add 1 to 2 fluid ounces of Anti-Foam per 100 gallons of spray mixture. For Recirculating Sprayers: Add 4 fluid ounces per 100 gallons of spray mixture. If Foam Has Already Occurred: Add 6 fluid ounces per 100 gallons of spray mixture.

First Aid

If in Eyes: Rinse continuously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do; continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists, get medical attention.
