General Information

Mainstay is a water dispersible, nonionic spreader-sticker adjuvant that is formulated to improve the efficiency of a variety of pesticides by increasing droplet spreading and adhesion onto leaf surfaces. Mainstay enhances efficacy of herbicide, insecticide and fungicide spray applications. Mainstay works by reducing water surface tension to increase coverage while forming a protective film to adhere active ingredients to the plant surface. Mainstay improves spray droplet deposition and suppresses off-target drift by producing a more uniform droplet spray pattern. The sticking properties in Mainstay help to reduce tendency for wash-off of the spray deposit caused by light rainfall or irrigation.

Directions For Use

For use with products registered for agricultural, forestry, industrial, municipal, non-cropland, ornamental, rights-of-way, turf and other uses.

Always read and follow instructions of the pesticide label regarding the use of an adjuvant.
